Course Description

This is the Department of Health & Human Services-Children's Behavioral Health Services (DHHS-CBHS) Behavioral Health Professional (BHP) training certification program. The training is designed to give the participant the competencies, in conjunction with agency supervision, required to deliver in-home and community-based or Rehabilitation and Community Support services. This training is required by DHHS-CBHS for BHP certification.

This is a 50-hour training program and will cover the following topics:

3. Typical Child & Family Development & Child Pathology
4. Trauma
5. Individual Treatment Plan

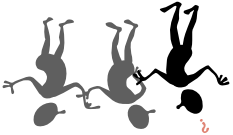
